## DEC Summer Camp Registration Opens January 25, 2017

Hunter Safety, Bow and Trapper Education will be offered at each camp.

Clubs are encouraged to sponsor children for a week at camp. Groups who sponsor six paid campers will receive a scholarship to send a seventh child free.

The weekly fee for the 2017 summer camp season is \$350 for supplies, all meals, t-shirt and accommodations for five nights.

There will be seven weeks of camp offered at Rushford, Colby and DeBruce and eight weeks at Pack Forest. Pack Forest will host two weeks for ages 11 - 13; weeks 4 (July 16-21) and 8 (August 13-18) will offer programs similar to the other three camps. All the other weeks of camp at Pack Forest will be for ages 14 - 17. Camp Rushford will offer two sessions of camp for the 14 - 17 age group during weeks 4 (July 16-21) and 5 (July 23-28).

The Outdoor Skills Adventure week provides an opportunity for 14-17 year olds to speak with professionals about career choices, participate and gain experience in more advanced activities, and take advantage of fishing in more habitats.
